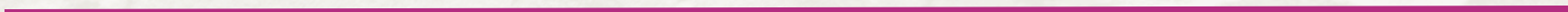
~~Now this is a story all about how

I put my Walkman on and said, "I might as well kick it"~~



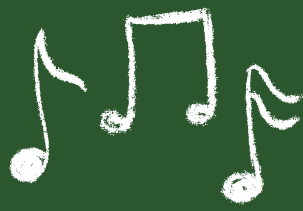
**'Bout one-eight-zero-zero econ'

To sit on my throne as the Prince of Bel Air~~

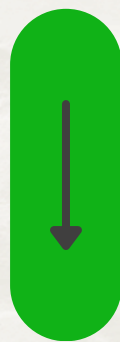


**We consume Earths at the rate of
